2:18 So I loathed all the fruit of my effort,

There is nothing gained from them on earth."

for which I worked so hard on earth, because I must leave it behind in the hands of my successor. 2:19 Who knows if he will be a wise man or a fool? Yet he will be master over all the fruit of my labor

for which I worked so wisely on earth!

This also is **futile**!

2:16 For the wise man, like the fool, will not be remembered for very long, because in the days to come, both will already have been forgotten.

Alas, the wise man dies—just like the fool!

## 2:24 There is nothing better for people than to eat and drink, and to find enjoyment in their work.

I also perceived that **this ability to find enjoyment comes from God.** 2:25 For no one can eat and drink or experience joy apart from him.



<sup>8</sup>For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, <sup>9</sup> not a result of works, so that no one may boast. <sup>10</sup>For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.
