Monday – 1 Cor 2:1-5

- 1. What philosophy did Paul preach at Corinth? -Vs. 1-2
- 2. How was Paul's message to the Corinthians different from that of the false teachers in Colossae? Vs. 3-4 (See Col 2:8)
- 3. What was the confidence the Corinthians had if they accepted Paul's philosophy? -Vs.5

Tuesday – 1 Cor 2:6-13

- 1. How did one come to understand the philosophy Paul preached? Vs. 6-11
- 2. How do we know that Paul's message came from God? Vs. 11
- 3. How do we know that we are understanding the truth and not believing falsehood? Vs. 12-13

Wednesday- 1 Cor 2:14-16

- 1. What is the attitude of non-believers to the philosophy Paul preached? Vs. 13
- 2. What is required in order for someone to understand and accept the philosophy preached by Paul? Vs. 14
- 3. What is the promise of God as we encounter philosophy? Vs. 16

Thursday – **Romans 6:3-5** (Assume that our water baptism is a picture of what this passage teaches)

- 1. When is a person baptized into Christ? Vs. 3
- 2. Col 2:11-13 speaks of being buried, raised and made alive in Christ. How does this passage say the same thing?
- 3. What is the promise of Vs. 5?

Friday – Eph 2:11-16

- 1. How does Paul describe our need for forgiveness? Vs. 11-12
- 2. How does Paul describe forgiveness? Vs. 14-16
- 3. Who in the initiator of our forgiveness? Vs. 13 (see also vs. 4-5)

Saturday – 1 Peter 5:8-10

- 1. What is the warning concerning our enemy Satan and his evil army?
- 2. What is significant about the fact that Satan is compared to a lion who roars? (Hint: Lions roar in order to paralyze their pray before attacking them. See also Col 2:15)
- 3. What is our battle plan against the roaring Satan? Vs. 9-10
